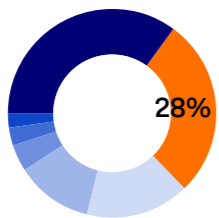
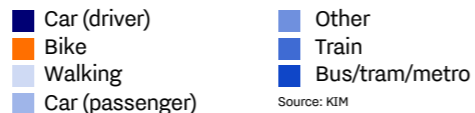


Cycling in the Netherlands

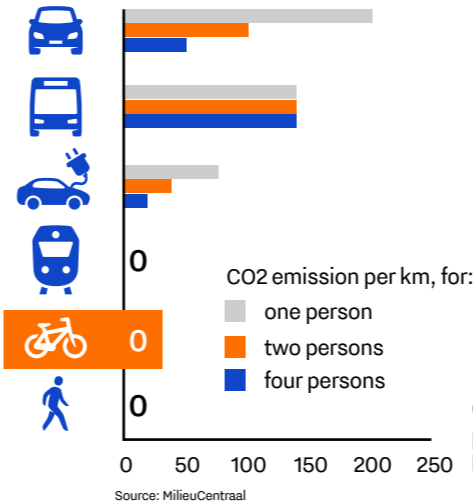

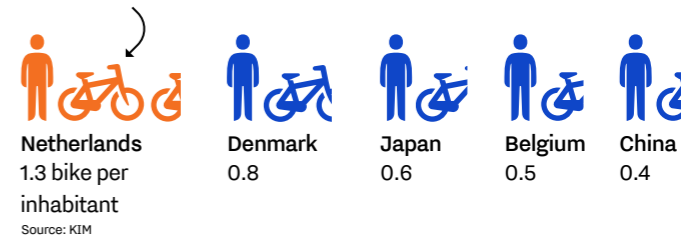
